















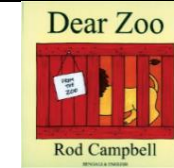

### Zookeeper

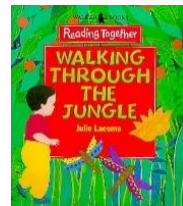
